

Relevant Experience

The ratio of non-relevant to relevant applicants per job is normally quite high (often 20:1 in favour of non-relevant). A culmination of reasons can be the reason behind a low success rate. If you are unsure as to why you are not receiving a call back following your applications and you would like to discuss your options our team are always happy to help.

Constructing a CV can sometimes be a bit of a chore. This is true if your own professional experience does not excite you enough to write about it. In this instance it is unlikely to excite the recipient of hiring manager either. It is therefore worth amending your CV so that it excites both you and the person you are sending it too. Additionally recent experience within a capacity that does not assist you in the role or roles that you are applying for is often not worth focusing on.

You might be thinking; "If I am applying for 20 jobs, why should I tailor my CV 20 times, everyday?" Whilst this is partially true, applying for 20 jobs is a cause for concern. This may suggest that your CV is not answering the concerns that employers have about you, not that you are unsuited to the role.

It is again surprising how many inaccurate, outdated or poorly constructed CV's are received. Often, this is the reason for non-responses as opposed to a lesser skill set.
